



MW&L List of Residential Conservation Incentives; effective 10/1/2018 to 9/30/2019

Site Built and Manufactured Homes (MH):

- Heat Pumps
 - \$1,050-Forced Air Electric Furnace (FAF) replaced with 14 SEER, 9.0 HSPF, PTCS certified heat pump
 - \$1,200-FAF replaced with a minimum 14 SEER, 9.0 HSPF, PTCS Variable Speed Heat Pump
 - \$375-Existing older heat pump, forced air gas, forced air oil, or zonal heat (ceiling cable heat, baseboard or electric wall heaters) replaced with 14 SEER, 9.0 HSPF, PTCS heat pump
 - \$525-Existing older heat pump, forced air gas, forced air oil, or zonal heat replaced with 14 SEER, 9.0 HSPF, PTCS Variable Speed Heat Pump
 - \$225-for new code heat pump, with PTCS Commissioning and Controls
 - Ductless Heat Pumps: Zonal to one head DHP: \$600, FAF to one head DHP: \$750
 - New Zonal to multi-head DHP: **\$750**, FAF to multi-head: **\$900** site built only, 8.2 HSPF Existing or New MH, FAF to one or multi-head: \$750
 - New Site built New Construction, one or multi-head: **\$300**
 - New Upgrade from old DHP, site built or MH/one or multi-head: **\$75**, 11.0 HSPF
- Replacement Windows & Doors \$2/square foot, .30 U-factor / \$30 per Energy Star Door

Site Built Homes only:

- Duct sealing (tested and prescriptive): \$190
 - Tested Air Sealing: \$0.15/ΔCFM50; Prescriptive: \$0.06/sq. ft. Attic, \$0.06/sq. ft. Under-floor
 - Wall Insulation: \$0.45/sq. ft.
- Attic insulation:
 - R0-7 to R38, R49 \$0.46, \$0.48/sq. ft.
 - R8-11 to R38, R49 \$0.19, \$0.20/sq. ft.
 - R12-19 to R38, R49 \$0.08, \$0.10/sq. ft.
- Under-floor Insulation:
 - R0 to R19, R25, R30 \$0.19, \$0.23, \$0.25/square foot
- Heat Pump Water Heaters Tier 1, 50 gal: \$225; Tier 1 that is 75 gal: \$375; Tier 2 and 3: \$375

Manufactured Homes only:

- New Duct Sealing (tested and prescriptive): **\$150**
- Tested Air Sealing: \$0.20/ΔCFM50
- Attic insulation:
 - R0-11 to R30 \$0.19/sq. ft. R11-19 to R30 \$0.11/sq. ft.
- Under-floor insulation:
 - R0 to R22+ \$0.225/sq. ft. R11 to R22+ \$0.15/sq. ft.

Also available but not shown are incentives for new homes, Low-E storm windows, and multi-family weatherization and windows. Also ask about the MW&L Conservation Loan Program
