Conditions of Service

1. Explanation of Service

MW&L purchases power from renewable resources. As part of these purchases, MW&L receives Renewable Energy Credits (RECs). RECs are property rights to the environmental benefits from generating electricity from renewable energy sources. Certificates representing RECs can be sold and traded and the owner of the REC can legally claim to have purchased renewable energy. Customers who receive service under this schedule will purchase RECs from MW&L. Green power in the form of RECs purchased under this schedule may not be resold and any RECs sold to MW&L customers under this program will be retired.

The source of the Biomethane product is projects fueled by biomass or biogas. The Green Melded product may consist of a blend of wind, low impact hydro, solar or other non-biomethane renewable generation resource.

2. Application

MW&L's Green Power rate is an optional service. This charge is in addition to the regular energy use charges billed under the customer's applicable rate schedule.

A "Green Power Rate" customer chooses to purchase the Green Melded or a Biomethane product. MW&L's electric customers may sign up, change their participation level, or discontinue participation at any time, in whole billing period segments.

Customers will purchase the products offered in this schedule in 100 kWh blocks of RECs. In order to allow all customers to participate in the service, MW&L reserves the

right to limit the number of blocks sold to an individual customer to the customer's forecasted electric load. MW&L may limit the sale of either product offered under this schedule based on MW&L's available inventory of RECs.
